Communion under 'both kinds'



In future at all Masses we will have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion under 'both kinds'.

This means that we can receive the Sacred Host and the Precious Blood.

To enable this to happen everyone needs to come down the centre aisle to receive the Sacred Host and then receive the Precious Blood, if you so wish, from one of the Ministers of Holy Communion who will be standing at each side of the altar steps.

If anyone is physically unable to come forward for Holy Communion please let the Priests know and they will bring it to you.

You may find this change confusing at first but we will soon get used to it and it is a great privilege to be able to receive Holy Communion in this way.
